VII Conditions of Competition

Motorcycles have to be compliant with EMF Enduro technical conditions. By registering competitor confirms that motorcycle is compliant with EMF rules and racer has a driving license of category needed.

The noise emission of motorcycle must not exceed 114 db.

Scoring is in accordance with EMF rules.

In order to give out the title of Estonian Champion in classes Enduro 1, Enduro 2, Enduro 3 and Veterans 40+, at least 5 competitors have to be presented in the race.

Competitions are held individually and among club teams. Teams consist of 3-5 members, 4 of the best results will count. In classes E1, E2, E3 teams consist of up to 2 members, senior 40+ and hobby have 1 member. For Hobby class coefficient is 0.5.

Track: the length of the lap is 68km and it has

1 Enduro test/ ET
1 Cross Test/ CT
1 Extreme Test/ EX

On both days first lap has 2 Extreme Tests.

The lap has: 3 Time Control points (TC)
3 Control points (CP)

Number of laps in classes:

E1, E2, E3, Senior 40+ 3 laps on first day and 2 laps on second day

Hobby 2 laps on both days

Beginners C, Juniors 1 lap on both days

ATV 2 laps on first day and 1 lap on second day

Veteran 50+ 2 laps on first day and 1 lap on second day

Trial 2 laps on first day and 1 lap on second day

(The number of laps can be changed upon the wishes of Trial competitors. It will be decided on Saturday morning)

MAMMOTHS (motorcycles 135kg+) 1 lap on both days

NB! Depending on the weather conditions the clerk of the course has the right to change the number of laps.

Exceeding the speed limit on roads and streets means every km/h = 1 penalty minute. Allowed error is +5 km/h.

It is mandatory to use carpet while filling tank.

NB! Fueling is only permitted in Time Control points (TC).

VIII Awarding

Top three of each class will be awarded with cups.

Top three of the championship in general will be awarded with cups.

Top three of club teams will be awarded with cups.

USEFUL INFORMATION

On both days the track is indicated by **RED** waymarks. **KTM** tape is used to indicate “go ahead” and “right way”. **HUSABERG** tapes indicate “wrong way”. On both days the track will be driven clockwise.

On both days the first lap starts and ends with Extreme Test.

On first lap the cross test CT and the second extreme test (EX) will be taken into account. For racers that have participated in the race on previous years, we recommend to walk through the tests, especially cross test (CT), that will be taken into account.

Extreme test (**EX**) length 1,3km (with possibility of detour)

Enduro test (**ET**) length 4,6km

Cross test (**CT**) length 4,6km

The length of tests can be changed depending on the weather conditions.
