6. RIDERS AND MOTORCYCLES

All riders must hold a valid license to take part. Participants are obliged to present a valid national or international license issued by the federation of the rider's origin.

Riders that don't have a valid season license can obtain a one-time starting permit at the registration (25€, for FT 50, SW Mikro).

Ignition cut-out switch is compulsory for all motorcycles.

7. PRE-REGISTRATION

Pre-registration on page <http://www.msport.ee/events/speedway-emv-i-etapp-2016/> is open until 4th of May 2016. Pre-registration is **compulsory**.

After the pre-registration period the rider is allowed to race only by the decision of the Jury (double registration fee applies).

All classes consist maximum of 16 riders.

Participation fee: SW Mikro, SW 85, FT 50, FT 65, – **20 €**; SW 125 hobi, SW 250, SW 500, SW 500 Kv – **30 €**.

Every rider has 2 minutes of practice, 4 riders are allowed on track at the same time.

Practice and heat order: FT 50, FT 65, SW Mikro, SW 85, SW 125 hobi, SW 250, SW 500, SW 500 Kv.

9. RACE FORMAT

The rider's starting numbers are determined by a ballot at registration.

All heats will be run with a maximum of 4 riders over 4 laps. Riders will be awarded points according to their finishing position in each race as follows: 1st – 3 points, 2nd – 2 points, 3rd – 1 point, 4th – 0 points.

Eight top-scoring riders from classification will qualify for the semi-finals. First two riders of the both semi-final will meet in the final where positions 1 to 4 of the meeting are determined. If less than 12 riders are registered semi-finals will not be held and 4 best placed riders of the classification will meet in the final.

10. PROTESTS

All protests must be in writing accompanied by the fee (50€, engine capacity measurement protest 200€) and submitted to the Secretary.
