ESTONIAN CUP ROUND I AND BALTIC CUP ROUND I

I. Time, place, competition classes:

Time: April 14, 2017

Place: Võerdla village, Jõelähtme parish, Harju county

Directions: From the Tallinn-Narva road turn to the Tallinna waste management centre roundabout. At the roundabout take the left turn to the Kiltri road. The competition centre is situated at the starting point of the motorcycle offroad track.

3. E-3
4. Seniors 40+
5. Veterans 50+
6. Hobby
7. Beginners
8. Juniors
9. Rookies
10. Women
11. Retro

The motorcycles in the classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 have to correspond to the general technical requirements of the EMF motocross category competition motorcycles. In the class 11 the motorcycles are following the „retro requirements“.

III. Timetable:

Registration and motorcycles in the starting area: 9:00-11:00

Registration for the competitors without pre-registration: 8:30-9:00

Riders' briefing (mandatory): 11:10



The competitors in the classes 5,7,8,9,10 and 11 complete 3 laps and start at 11:30.

The competitors in the classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 complete 4 laps and start at 13:30.

The starting order is decided by the organizer.

IV. Pre-registration:

Pre-registration is available till April 12 at 20:00 on the www.msport.ee web-page. The competitors who have not pre-registered must be at the secretariat to complete the registration from 8:30 to 9:00. Latecomers are not guaranteed participation in the race. The competitors are required to fill out all information correctly and truthfully. If it becomes apparent that the competitor has misrepresented information it is possible to cancel the result of this competitor.

V. The course of the competition:

The competition is run in the British style of enduro sprint where only the test is run.

The timing of the race starts from the first lap. All the test results will be summed up and on top of the sum the penalties earned in the race are added. The result of the race is decided by ranking the competitors by the least sum of time. The first 15 in the classes 1-9 will be awarded Baltic and Estonian Cup points according to the Estonian Enduro Sprint Cup Regulations.

Track: The track for the classes 1,2,3,4 and 6 is more complicated and the length is 6.7 km, with 1 enduro test (approximately 6.2 km), 1 time check (TC). The track for the classes 5,7,8,9,10, and 11 is less complicated and the length is 6.7 km, with 1 enduro test (approximately 6 km).

Participation Fee: Every competitor must pay a 40 EUR fee at the registration. The competitors without pre-registration have to pay an additional registration fee 10 EUR.

VI. Awarding: The top three (3) of each class are awarded with Cups.

VII. Other Information:

The track is closed for practice during the week preceding the race.
