1. General

The competition is held in accordance with the FIM Europe Sporting Code and FIM Europe Regulations for the European Cross Country Cup and this Supplementary Regulations that has been approved by the FIM Europe.

The competition will take place Saturday 12 of October at Paikuse (National road 59), Pärnu County, 6 km from Pärnu. Motorway E67 from Tallinn 132 km and from Riga 181 km.

6. Competitors

All the riders must hold a valid FIM/FIM Europe or National Enduro/Motocross license and have a starting permission from his/her National Federation (FMNR). Further on the rider has to have an insurance confirmed by his/her FMN and be a minimum age of 15 years.

7. Cancellation

8. Course

The competition is a Cross Country Enduro on a marked circuit, lap distance 8,6 km. Solo classes the running time is 2 hours, quad running time is 1,5 hours.

Time limit.

All riders have to finish the race no later than 30 min after the overall winner has passed the finish line in order to complete the race.

The organizer reserves the right of changing the number of laps and the length of the circuit depending on the actual conditions on the day of the competition.

9. Administrative Control

Administrative control is 12 of October on the competition area at 8.00 a.m to 10.00 a.m. At the administrative inspection the rider must submit his/her FIM, FIM Europe or National License, confirmation of entry fee payment, starting permission from FMN confirming insurance.

10. Technical inspection

After Administrative Control is Technical inspection at 8.15 a.m to 10.15 a.m. It is allowed to use off road (MX) tires.

11. Environment

It is mandatory to use an Environmental mat in the Pit area. Rider who are assisted or have the bike refilled outside the Pit area or refilled with running engine on the Pit area will be disqualified.

12. Prizes and Prize Giving Ceremony

Prize giving ceremony will be at the track after last race.

Every class 3 best riders are awarded.

Overall 3 best riders are awarded.

13. Results

The official results will be put up at the Information Board.

14. Start

All starts will be conducted with stopped engine.

Groups and starting times will be clarified at the official board.

Classes 1-4 start at 11.00 a.m and class 5 at 14.00 p.m

15. Equipment

Riders, their bikes and protection clothing should comply with FIM Europe Regulations.

16. Classes

1. Junior - open from 100cc to 250cc 2T + from 175cc to 450cc 4T
2. Senior – open from 100cc to 500cc 2T + from 175cc to 650cc 4T
3. Veteran – open from 100cc to 500cc 2T + from 175cc to 650cc 4T
4. Women – open from 100cc to 500cc 2T + from 175cc to 650cc 4T
5. Quad – 2x4; 4x4, manual or automatic gearshift
