

1. Participants arriving at the place of the event must present a valid certificate of approval of negative Covid-19 test, vaccination or recovery from Covid-19.
2. Organizer must provide hand disinfection (containing at least 70% ethanol) or other disinfection solvents available for all staff and participants during the event.
3. In the mechanics zone 2m distance must be kept between each other, and protective masks must be used. There must be no crowding at the table displaying event results.
4. After the race or training, participant immediately returns to his zone in the paddock.
5. When holding the prize award ceremony only the 3 winners and one person for each prizewinner can be present.
9. Awards are placed on the pedestal, handshakes are not allowed, and the participants use face masks.
11. Organizer provides a paddock for the participants, that has no connection to the spectators.
12. Organizer must present a wrist band for each participant.
13. Organizer determines a person that is responsible for all epidemiological measures, and informs the participants and staff about all these measures. Organizer provides information for contacting this person.

All participants, staff, spectators and other persons involved in the event must be accredited.

In particular, all persons participating in the competition should:

- monitor own health and in the event of symptoms suggestive of coronavirus infection,
 - immediately stop participating in the competition and follow the recommendations of the
 - appropriate state authorities;
 - strictly comply with the applicable provisions of these Sanitary Regulations and the
 - recommendations of the Sanitary Commissioner;
 - limit movement between zones only to situations arising from the performance of duties;
 - promote appropriate anti-infection behavior, including regularly washing your hands and using disinfectants,
- from the moment of opening the stadium for participants throughout the competition until
