Traffic insurance and motorsport events in Finland

We want to inform the riders that in Finland the law states that the traffic insurance is acting as the third party insurance in the motorsport events. The rider can buy the insurance from his/hers home country to the bike that will be used in the event. If it is not possible to get the insurance to the bike in the riders own home country, it is possible to get a temporary insurance from Finland as the team or rider arrives to the country.

The fare is around 38 euros per day. Prices may vary.

The Finnish transfer permit and insurance can be applied in advance or on site in the city where the event is held. Please note that the Vehicle inspection and permit offices (katsastuskonttori in Finnish) will usually be open during weekdays and office ours 8.00-16.00. More detailed information will be available from the organizer (the address of the Vehicle inspection office in the city of the event).

The requirement for the transfer permit and insurance is for the rider to submit a declaration of taxexempt use for the Finnish Tax authority. If you are an EU citizen, you can fill in a contact request form in MyTax to start the processing of your tax matter.

You can log in to MyTax if you have an eIDAS identifier, i.e. online banking codes or other electronic identifier from another EU country.
