### **AGENDA AND DECISIONS**

#### **Question 1. Entry fee**

Decision: The entry fee for all classes is set at 100 EUR. Approved.

#### **Question 2. Championship classes**

Decision: The Baltic Supermoto Championship will include the following classes: S1, S4, SMJ. Approved unanimously.

#### **Question 3. Championship referee**

Decision: One FIM-licensed referee will be appointed for all championship rounds.

#### **Question 4. Practice, qualifying and race duration**

Decision: Practice – 10 minutes. Qualifying – 20 minutes. Races – two races of 20laps (Approx. 20min.).

#### **Question 5. Event schedule**

Decision: The schedule will be organized according to Cup and Championship order. Cup classes first, Championship classes after.

#### **Question 6. Technical requirements**

Decision: A waiting zone must be installed using EMU barriers and electricity supply must be provided in the waiting zone.

#### **Question 7. Pit lane and signaling area**

Decision: The pit lane and signaling area must be clearly separated and clearly marked.

#### **Question 8. Championship rounds**

Decision: The Baltic Supermoto Championship will consist of three rounds in Lithuania, Latvia, and Estonia.

#### **Question 9. First round**

Decision: Location – Madona, Latvia. Organizer – „Bruno Racing Team“. Responsible person – Normunds Freimanis.
